RODENT AND POSSUM SEASON

Winter months are when there is an increase in activity in mice and rats. They are looking for shelter in winter months and peoples roofs and wall cavities are perfect for this. Rodents in roof voids can cause excessive damage. Rodents eat through wires, exposing them may be a fire risk. This can also cause electric shortages and electrocution. It has been known they can eat through ducting and nest in insulation causing severe odors with their excrement. It is very hard to proof against rats and mice. Therefore preventative baiting program is most effective. It is a simple process, involving pest controller inspecting the roof void and building surrounds for most effective bait stations to ensure quick results. Bait is in a lockable station, safe from pets and people.







Possums in the roof void can cause sleepless nights, as they are active throughout the nights. They love nothing more then setting up home in people's roof spaces amongst the insulation. It is warm and dry in the roof great for possums. They have been known to damage roof tiles, eves, fascia, ducting and insulation.

Mice, rats and possum invade roofs and do hundreds of thousands of dollars worth of damage each month, especially in the winter months. Rodents in roof voids and the damage they cause can result in exposed wires. This can cause electrocution and house fires,
